National Memorial Day Events at Arlington National Cemetery

WHAT: Department of Defense Recognition and Commemoration of the Fallen Men and Women of the U.S. Armed Forces – 151st National Memorial Day Observance

WHEN: Monday, May 27 at 11 a.m.

WHERE: Community Center, Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall, Virginia

EVENT DETAILS:

7:30 a.m. Media Operations Center opens.

8 a.m. Media shuttle will begin transporting media to the ceremony site.

9:30 a.m. Media Operations Center closes and the final media shuttle departs to ceremony site.

10:30 a.m. United States Coast Guard Band begins the prelude concert inside Memorial Amphitheater.

11 a.m. **Presidential Armed Forces Full Honor Wreath-Laying Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier followed by an observance program hosted by Department of Defense in Arlington's Memorial Amphitheater.**
